


LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: 36° 56' S. LONGITUDE: 147° 42' E. MAG. VAR: 9° E. app.

ALTITUDE: 2,100 feet approx.

POSITION: On NE end of Lake Omeo, 1/2 mile SW of Benambra P.O.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator sheet K.8, Stripmap No.4.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Grazing land to S, otherwise hilly.

LANDMARKS: Lake Omeo, Mitta Mitta River to west, Bowen mountains to south-east.

APPROACHES: NW - over rising ground. SE - over fences and tel. line 20 ft. high. NE and SW - open.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: 880 yards x 880 yards.

SURFACE: Level, grassed sandy loam.

TOWN: Benambra (adjacent).

RAILWAY STATION: Bruthen, 79 miles.

TELEPHONE: Benambra.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Benambra.

WATER: On ground.

PROPRIETORS: The Committee of Management, Lake Omeo Reserve, P.O. Benambra.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Lake Omeo is dry except during the wet season, and is used for cattle grazing. Aerodrome probably boggy during wet weather.
