


WIRELESS MASTS AT BINDULI & MINDING, W.A.



A high wireless mast has been erected at each of the following positions, as shown on the sketches above.

BINDULI REGIONAL BROADCASTING STATION, 6 GF.

Lat: $30^{\circ} 48' 00''$ S. Long: $121^{\circ} 24' 00''$ E.
 Situated about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile N.W. of Binduli Rly. Stn., and $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles W. by N. from Kalgoorlie Aerodrome. Stripmaps Nos. 17 and 18.
 The mast is 400 feet high. Ground level at base is approx. 1,260 feet.

Throughout the night, and during other periods of bad visibility, red lights are displayed at the mast head and at one lower level.

MINDING REGIONAL BROADCASTING STATION, 6 WA.

Lat: $32^{\circ} 20' 00''$ S. Long: $117^{\circ} 05' 00''$ E.
 Situated approx. $14\frac{1}{2}$ miles W. by S. from Wagin. Stripmap: Nil.
 The mast is 660 feet high. Ground level at base is approx. 1,000 feet.

Obstruction lights are displayed at night, and during periods of bad visibility, only while the broadcasting staff is on duty. These lights are at the mast head and at three lower levels.
