



CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency landing ground.  
PROPRIETOR: Commonwealth of Australia (Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne). Owner: Mr. F.L.M. Burden, Victor Harbour.  
POSITION: One mile east of Birdwood.  
Lat.  $34^{\circ} 49\frac{1}{2}'$  S. Long.  $138^{\circ} 58'$  E.  
MAGNETIC VARIATION:  $6^{\circ}$  E. approx.  
LANDMARKS: Railway to north-west. Road junction at south-east corner.  
MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.  
SURFACE: Fair; ground rises to south and east.  
DIMENSIONS: N.W. - S.E. 500 yds. N.E. - S.W. 260 yds.  
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 1,350 ft. approx.  
APPROACHES: South, trees and tel. line 16 ft.; elsewhere open.  
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Rough and mountainous. Unsuitable for forced landings.  
PETROL AND OIL: Birdwood, about one mile west.  
WORKSHOPS: At garage, Birdwood.  
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.  
TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH: Birdwood P.O.  
NEAREST TOWN: Birdwood.  
NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Birdwood.  
CHARGES: Nil.  
REMARKS: Ground sometimes used for grazing sheep.
