


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

BOANA, N.G.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for single and light twin-engined types of landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: Lutheran Mission Finschhafen Incorporated, Finschhafen, New Guinea.

POSITION: On left bank of Bunzok River about 25 miles N.N.W. of Lae. Lat. $6^{\circ} 26' S$. Long. $146^{\circ} 51' E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$. approx.

LANDMARKS: Boana Mission Station $\frac{1}{2}$ mile N.W.; Wompangan village about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile north; ridge (4,000 ft.) about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to N.E.

MARKINGS: Nil.

SURFACE: Ground rising 1 in 20 for 130 yds. from northern end, then level; grassed surface good in all weathers.

DIMENSIONS: Single strip N. - S. 690 yds. x 60 yds. wide.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 3,000 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: From north, down valley over cleared grass lands. Immediately south of runway the ground falls abruptly for 1,500 ft., thereby giving clear approach from south.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Mountainous.

PETROL AND OIL: Lae, about 25 miles S.S.W.

WATER SUPPLY: At Mission Station, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile west.

WORKSHOPS: Lae.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEGRAPH: Radio at Lae.

NEAREST TOWN: Lae.
