


BONG BONG, N.S.W.



CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency landing ground.
PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).
POSITION: On main road between Moss Vale and Bowral.
Lat. $34^{\circ} 31' S$. Long. $150^{\circ} 24' E$.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: $9^{\circ} E$. approx.
LANDMARKS: Racecourse; road on eastern boundary; railway line on west.
MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.
DESCRIPTION: Fair surface. Area lies within fenced race track on Bong Bong Racecourse.
DIMENSIONS: N.E. - S.W. 660 yards; width 340 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 2170 ft. approx.
APPROACHES: Scattered timber with many clear openings.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally timbered and unsuitable for forced landings.
PETROL AND OIL: Moss Vale, $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles south, or Bowral $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles north.
WATER SUPPLY: House to north.
WORKSHOPS: Moss Vale or Bowral.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
TELEPHONE: At house adjoining to north.
TELEGRAPH: Moss Vale or Bowral.
NEAREST TOWN: Moss Vale or Bowral.
RAILWAY STATION: Burradoo.
CHARGES: Nil.
REMARKS: Cattle graze on landing ground. Landings are not to be made on race days.
