



DATA SHEET FOR LANDING GROUND NO.151 BONNIEVILLE, QLD.

(REVISED - OCTOBER, 1940)

EMERGENCY LANDING GROUND



LATITUDE: $26^{\circ} 19\frac{1}{2}' S$; LONGITUDE: $146^{\circ} 11\frac{1}{2}' E$; MAG. VAR: $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ app.

ALTITUDE: 1,000 feet approx.

POSITION: About 6 miles NNW from Charleville, on north side of main road to Ward River.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet G.8. Stripmaps Nos. 3, 57 and 59.

LANDMARKS: "L" shaped ground with windmill and yards on north side; house and shed on west side.

APPROACHES: North - over yards and shade trees. East, west and south - felled back for two chains, then over low timber with scattered gums to 60 ft. high.

MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 440 yds. E-W, 495 yds.

SURFACE: Fairly long grass, but quite safe.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Charleville, 6 miles SSE.

TELEPHONE: Charleville.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Charleville.

WATER: At home nearby.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.

CHARGES: Nil.
