


POSITION: About 1½ miles north west of Brighton Railway Junction. About 15 miles North North-West of Hobart. Latitude S.42° 41'. Longitude, E.147° 10'.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: River to north, main road and railway to east, railway junction south east, race course south-west.

MARKINGS: Ground mark (circle). Boundary marks and wind indicator.

DESCRIPTION: Irregular shaped ground with sandy surface.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 660 yds. E-W, 700 yds.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 100 feet approx.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 8° 27' E. approx.

APPROACHES: North and West clear. East, Telephone and Electric Light wires 30 ft. high. South, Racecourse and football gd.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally hilly.

PETROL AND OIL: Hobart.

WATER SUPPLY: River to north.

WORKSHOPS: Hobart.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: *Nil. 2 small hangars erected. 1/36.*

NEAREST TELEPHONE: Pontville or Brighton.

NEAREST TELEGRAPH: Pontville or Brighton.

NEAREST TOWN: Pontville ½ mile to North East.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Brighton Junction, 1½ miles.
