


 BROOME, W.A.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.
PROPRIETORS: The Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).
POSITION: About half a mile north of township of Broome.
 Lat. $17^{\circ} 57' S$. Long. $122^{\circ} 13\frac{1}{2}' E$.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: $2^{\circ} E$. approx.
LANDMARKS: Township of Broome immediately to south.
MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.
SURFACE: Good, level, grassed, sandy surface.
DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 770 yards. E. - W. 750 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 20 ft. approx.
APPROACHES: North, over scrub and scattered timber; south, W/T mast 160 ft. high, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile distant, power line and road; east, tel. line 14 ft. high; west, timber to 20 ft. high, scrub and felled approach.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Marsh on eastern side, otherwise timber.
PETROL AND OIL: At aerodrome.
WATER SUPPLY: At aerodrome.
WORKSHOPS: Broome, immediately south.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: One hangar 53 ft. x 43 ft.
TELEPHONE: At aerodrome.
TELEGRAPH: Broome (or by telephone).
NEAREST TOWN: Broome.
SEAPORT: Broome.
CHARGES: Nil at present.
REMARKS: The attention of pilots is drawn to the W/T mast, 160 ft. high, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south of aerodrome. Golf club on aerodrome. Relative strip map No. 55.
