


BULOLO, N.G.



CLASS OF GROUND: One-way aerodrome licensed for all types of landplanes.

PRIPRIETORS: Bulolo Gold Dredging Ltd., Bulolo, New Guinea.

POSITION: On west bank of Bulolo River, about 12 miles north-east of Wau. Lat. $7^{\circ}11\frac{1}{2}'S$. Long. $146^{\circ}39'E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$. approx.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Bulolo River to east, junction of the Upper Watut and Bulolo Rivers about 5 miles N.N.W.

MARKINGS: Nil.

DESCRIPTION: Straight, narrow runway with grassy surface.

DIMENSIONS: N.W. - S.E. 1170 yards, by 240 yards wide.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 7,300 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: N.W. - Round the shoulder of a hill 200 ft. high.
S.E. - Timber felled back from end of ground.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Mountainous and heavily timbered; unsuitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: At Lae and Salamaua, on sea coast.

WATER SUPPLY: At camp adjacent to aerodrome.

WORKSHOPS: Bulolo Gold Dredging Ltd. camp, adjacent.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

WIRELESS TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Bulolo Gold Dredging Ltd. camp adjacent. (Call letters, V.L.T.)

NEAREST TOWN: Wau, 12 miles S.E.

CHARGES: Nil.

REMARKS: Not to be used by aircraft, under conditions which necessitate a take-off across the aerodrome.
