



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all types of landplanes.
PROPRIETORS: Bulolo Gold Dredging Ltd.

POSITION: On right (east) bank of Watut River, 2 miles north of the junction of Upper Watut and Bulolo Rivers.

Lat. $7^{\circ}6'S.$ Long. $146^{\circ}38'E.$

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. approx.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Watut River on west. Bulwa Camp buildings on east.

MARKINGS: Nil.

DESCRIPTION: Single runway only, running approximately N.E. - S.W. Good level surface.

DIMENSIONS: N.E. - S.W. 875 yards by 200 yards wide.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 2000 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: S.W. - Over clearing and Watut River.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: "Kunai"* grass hills.
