


 CAIRNS, QLD.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all single and light multi-engined landplanes (under favourable conditions only).
PROPRIETORS: The Cairns City Council, Council Chambers, Cairns.
POSITION: About 2½ miles N.E. of Cairns, alongside Cairns-Herberton railway. Lat. 16° 53' E. Long. 145° 44' S.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: 6° E. approx.
LANDMARKS: West, Mt. Whitfield, 1250', Lumley Hill, 1090', and a mountainous range; north, Barron River; south, Cairns.
MARKINGS: Circular ground mark and wind indicator.
SURFACE: Saltpan, mangrove flat. Ground falls slightly to east.
DIMENSIONS: N. - S. about 700 yards; E. - W. about 500 yards.
 Prepared runway along western boundary, 660 yards long.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: Few inches only (subject to inundation).
APPROACHES: West, 45' H.T. line, tel. line, road and railway; elsewhere, mangroves 20' high.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: North, saltpan suitable for forced landings; west, wooded mountains; elsewhere, mangroves.
PETROL AND OIL: Garages at Cairns.
WATER SUPPLY: Nearest house.
WORKSHOPS: Cairns.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: On site, for one light 'plane, folded.
TELEPHONE: At house ½ mile south of aerodrome.
TELEGRAPH: Cairns Post Office.
NEAREST TOWN: Cairns.
NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Edge Hill siding, ½ mile south.
CHARGES: 1-2 seater plane, 2/6 per landing, 10/- per day;
 3-4 " " 5/- " " 15/- " "
 5-6 " " 7/6 " " 25/- " "
 over 6 " " 10/- " " 40/- " "

REMARKS: Aerodrome to be used only when wind, tide and weather conditions involve no risk.
