


NOTICE TO AIRMEN

NO. 49 /1936.

CAMBRIDGE, TAS.



CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for use by all types of landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.)

POSITION: On the banks of Barilla Bay (Pitt Water), 7 miles N.E. of Bellerive. Lat. $42^{\circ} 50' S.$; Long. $147^{\circ} 30' E.$

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $8\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E.$ approx.

LANDMARKS: South - Bellerive-Sorell road. North and East - Barilla Bay.

MARKINGS: White circle, boundary marks, wind indicators.

SURFACE: Clayey soil. Fall towards Barilla Bay. Gravel runways.

DIMENSIONS: Runways - N.W. - S.E. 750 yards; E. - W. 600 yards; N.E. - S.W. 600 yards (see "plan").

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 30 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: West - open. North - generally open. East - open and Barilla Bay. South - timber 30'.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: West - open, rising to timbered hills.

East - Barilla Bay. North - open. South - timber with some open areas.

PETROL AND OIL: On aerodrome.

WATER SUPPLY: Tanks on aerodrome.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: One - 90' x 100' span (Holymans Airways).

TELEPHONE: On aerodrome - Bellerive 97 (Holymans Airways).

TELEGRAPH: P.O. Cambridge, one mile.

NEAREST TOWN: Bellerive, seven miles.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Hobart.

CHARGES: Nil.

REMARKS: Strip Map No. 48.
