


## NOTICE TO AIRMEN

NO.86/1936  
CAMPANIA, TAS.

**CLASS OF GROUND:** Aerodrome suitable for single and light multi-engined air-craft.

**PROPRIETOR:** D. Ransom, Esq., "Cranston", Campania, Tasmania.

**POSITION:** About  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles N.N.E. from Campania.

Lat.:  $42^{\circ} 39' S$ .; Long.:  $147^{\circ} 27\frac{1}{2}' E$ .

**MAGNETIC VARIATION:**  $8\frac{1}{2}'$  approx.

**LANDMARKS:** Coal River along East boundary. Railway line and two hills to the West. Road on North. Racecourse to the South.

**MARKINGS:** Wind indicator and boundary marks in N.E. corner.

**SURFACE:** Good.

**DIMENSIONS:** N.-S. 480 yards; E.-W. 590 yards; NW.-SE. 830 yards.

**HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL:** 500 feet.

**APPROACHES:** North - clear. East - over odd trees along river.

Hills about 1000 yards away. West and South - over tree-covered hills 200-300 ft. high.

**SURROUNDING COUNTRY:** In places suitable for forced landings.

**PETROL AND OIL:** Small quantities available at homestead.

**WATER SUPPLY:** At Coal River, adjoining.

**WORKSHOPS:** Garage at homestead.

**HANGAR ACCOMMODATION:** Nil.

**TELEPHONE:** At homestead.

**TELEGRAPH:** At Campania,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles S.S.W.

**NEAREST TOWN:** Campania.

**RAILWAY STATION:** Lowdina,  $\frac{3}{4}$  mile West.

**CHARGES:** Nil.

**REMARKS:** Ground should be useable in all weathers.
