

NOTICES TO AIRMEN.

No. 34 of 1925.

IT is hereby notified that an Emergency Landing Ground has been established at CANALLY, NEW SOUTH WALES.

The following particulars regarding this Emergency Landing Ground are published for information:—

<i>Position</i>	Latitude, 34° 38' S.; longitude, 143° 21' E. Situated 15 miles west of Balranald on north side of telegraph line adjoining and west of Waldaira ground.
<i>Distinctive Features</i>	..	Large plain $\frac{1}{4}$ mile west of edge of mallee and immediately north of Balranald-Euston-road.
<i>Markings</i>	Ground marking (white cross). Wind indicator near south-east corner.
<i>Description</i>	A flat cleared of light scrub, very level, fairly smooth surface. Some gilgai holes just outside the ground on west and south-west.
<i>Dimensions for Landing</i>		North and south, 550 yards. East and west, 480 yards.
<i>Height above Sea Level</i>		About 300 feet.
<i>Magnetic Variation</i>	..	7° 10' E. (approx.).
<i>Approaches</i>	North, over low scattered scrub. South, telegraph line along roads. East, low fence. West, low scattered scrub.
<i>Surrounding Country</i>	..	Plain north, east, and south, rough surface, bad for landings. Mallee west.
<i>Petrol and Oil</i>	..	Balranald, 15 $\frac{1}{2}$ miles east.
<i>Water Supply</i>	..	Waldaira tank, 1 mile west-south-west.
<i>Workshops</i>	Balranald, for minor repairs.
<i>Hangar Accommodation</i>		Nil.
<i>Nearest Telephone</i>	..	Balranald.
<i>Nearest Telegraph</i>	..	Balranald.
<i>Nearest Town</i>	..	Balranald, 15 miles.
<i>Nearest Railway Station</i>		Robinvale, about 36 miles west.
<i>Charges</i>	Nil.
<i>Remarks</i>	This ground replaces Waldaira ground, which adjoins it to the east. Waldaira ground will no longer be maintained.
