

LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: 28°52½' S. LONGITUDE: 153°03' E. MAG. VAR: 9° E. approx.

ALTITUDE: 70 feet approx.

POSITION: One mile south-east from Casino Railway Station.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet H.9. Stripmap No.2.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Undulating and mostly open.

LANDMARKS: Circular reservoir on hill NW of aerodrome (2 obstruction lights). Show Ground on the west, and race-course ½ mile to the south.

APPROACHES: Gaps in scattered trees, felled close to boundaries.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and white boundary marks on southern boundary. (Other three sides fenced.)

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 615 yards; E-W, 725 yards; NW-SE, 1050 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN: South Casino, ¼ mile.

RAILWAY STATION: Casino, 1 mile NW.

TELEPHONE: House, 10 chains.

HANGARS: One, galvanized iron, 28 ft. x 18 ft. x 15 ft. high.

REFUELLING: South Casino garages, ¼ mile.

REPAIRS: Casino, 1 mile.

WATER: On ground.

PROPRIETORS: Casino Municipal Council.

CHARGES: Nil for ordinary tourist fliers. For commercial flights as under :-

1-2	seater planes	10/-	per day.
3-4	"	20/-	" "
5-6	"	30/-	" "
Over 6	"	40/-	" "

SPECIAL REMARKS: Surface beyond the southern boundary is swampy.
