




CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.
PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).
POSITION: About 2 miles east of Ceduna, on south-east side of Ceduna - Port Lincoln railway.
Lat. $32^{\circ}7\frac{1}{2}'S$. Long. $133^{\circ}42'E$.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: 4 E. approx.
DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Railway line on N.W. boundary; Ceduna-Wirrulla road on north boundary.
MARKINGS: White Circle and two Wind Indicators.
DESCRIPTION: Sandy loam, good in all weathers. Ground rises slightly from all sides to the centre. Fenced all round.
DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 1,000 yards. E. - W. 1,000 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 25 ft. approx.
APPROACHES: North - Over road and telegraph line. South, East and West. - Over low trees. North-west - Over railway and telegraph line.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally suitable for forced landings.
PETROL AND OIL: On aerodrome.
WATER SUPPLY: At rest house on aerodrome.
WORKSHOPS: Ceduna, about 2 miles west.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
TELEPHONE: On aerodrome.
TELEGRAPH: Ceduna Post Office.
NEAREST TOWN: Ceduna.
NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Ceduna.




ALTITUDE: 50 feet approx.

POSITION: 5 miles ENE of Ceduna.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Undulating, cleared agricultural and grazing country, some timbered areas.

LANDMARKS: Town of Ceduna, 5 miles WSW. Government aerodrome 4 miles WSW. Railway line 1 mile north.

APPROACHES: N - clear; NW - mallee 25 feet high; S - clear; E and W - clump of mallee 25 feet high in centre of boundary.

MARKINGS: Wind indicator, white circle, boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 1,300 yards; E-W, 1,400 yards.

SURFACE: Grassed sandy surface, general slope to SW.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Ceduna, 5 miles WSW.

TELEPHONE: Ceduna.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Ceduna.

WATER: Homestead, 1 mile south.
