


EMERGENCY LANDING GROUND



LATITUDE:  $26^{\circ} 25' S.$  LONGITUDE:  $146^{\circ} 19' E.$  MAG. VAR:  $6\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E.$  app.  
ALTITUDE: 1020 feet approx.

POSITION: 4 miles E of Charleville, on N side of railway.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator sheet G.8. Stripmaps Nos. 3, 57 and 59.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered, generally unsuitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Meat Works and Railway immediately south.

APPROACHES: Over timber in all directions. Timber felled back for 5 chains at ends of each runway.

MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: NE-SW, 550 yards. WNW-ESE, 660 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Charleville, 4 miles west.

TELEPHONE: Possibly at Meat Works, if not, at Charleville.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Charleville.

WATER: At nearby Meat Works.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.

CHARGES: Nil.
