




LATITUDE: $18^{\circ}40\frac{1}{2}'$ S. LONGITUDE: $141^{\circ}42\frac{1}{2}'$ E. MAG. VAR. $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. app.
ALTITUDE: 200 feet approx.

POSITION: $\frac{3}{4}$ mile SSW of Claraville Homestead.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet E.7. Stripmap No. 63.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered. Unsuitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Clara River and Iffley-Croydon Road. Homestead and
yards $\frac{1}{2}$ mile NNE of ground.

APPROACHES: Over timber in all directions.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and white tins along
boundary.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 550 yards. SW-NE, 580 yards. (See sketch).

SURFACE: Claypan. Fairly good wet weather surface.

TOWN: Croydon, 55 miles NE.

RAILWAY: Croydon.

TELEPHONE: Croydon.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Croydon. Small repairs may be attended to at the H.S.

REFUELLING: Small supplies kept at homestead.

WATER: At homestead.
