



NOTICE TO AIRMEN.

COFF'S HARBOUR, N.S.W.



CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency landing ground.

PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.

POSITION: 1 mile south south-west of Coff's Harbour Jetty.

Lat. $30^{\circ} 19'$ S. Long. $153^{\circ} 06'$ E.MAGNETIC VARIATION: 9° E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Railway and coast line on eastern side. Range of hills approx. 4 miles west.

MARKINGS: Boundary and ground marks (white circle*). Wind indicator.

SURFACE: Rough.

DIMENSIONS: North-South: 700 yards. East-West: 720 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 16 feet.

APPROACHES: North and west: Open. East: Over low trees.

South: Over line of timber running NE-SW. NW: Over telephone line 20' high.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered, with some open spaces.

PETROL AND OIL: On ground. (Shell and Voco).

WATER SUPPLY: Well.

WORKSHOPS: Coff's Harbour.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH: Coff's Harbour P.O.

NEAREST TOWN: Coff's Harbour, 1 mile NNE.

RAILWAY STATION: Coff's Harbour.

REMARKS: * White circle will be replaced by cross at later date.
