

NOTICE TO AIRMEN NO. 11/1928.  
(REVISED AND REPRINTED 1935) COODE ISLAND, VIC.



CLASS OF GROUND: Private aerodrome licensed for all types of landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: Larkin Aircraft Supply Co. Ltd., Melbourne.

POSITION: On Coode Island, at junction of Maribyrnong and Yarra Rivers, between city of Melbourne and Hobson's Bay.  
Lat.  $37^{\circ} 49' S$ . Long.  $144^{\circ} 56' E$ .

MAGNETIC VARIATION: About  $8^{\circ} E$ .

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: River confluence.

MARKINGS: Hangar roof marked "Melbourne Airport." Wind indicator on hangar.

DESCRIPTION: Irregular shape, good level surface.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 700 yards.  
E. - W. 470 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: About 10 feet.

APPROACHES: Clear on all sides.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally unsuitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: On aerodrome.

WATER SUPPLY: On aerodrome.

WORKSHOPS: Aircraft factory on aerodrome.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Yes.

TELEPHONE: On aerodrome (Central 6451).

TELEGRAPH: By telephone from aerodrome.

NEAREST TOWN: City of Melbourne, about  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Spencer Street, Melbourne, about  $2\frac{1}{2}$  miles.

REMARKS: This is a private aerodrome, and arrangements for landing should be made with the proprietors.
