


CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for light aeroplanes and for medium single-engined types, in favourable winds.

PROPRIETORS: The Cook Shire Council, P.O. Box 3, Cooktown.

POSITION: About one mile south-west of Cooktown, on racecourse. Lat. 15° 29' S. Long. 145° 14½' E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 6° E. approx.

LANDMARKS: Railway line skirting mud flats of Endeavour River to north. Mountains to south and south-east. Creek on east boundary.

MARKINGS: White semi-circle and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Grassed sandy loam. Good in wet weather.

DIMENSIONS: N.W. - S.E. 660 yds, width 220 yds.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 6 ft.

APPROACHES: N.W. - Low mangroves and tel. line 15 ft. high along railway. S.E. - Low trees to road thence timber 40 ft. high on rising ground, extending to Keating's Gap between Mahmie Peak and Mt. Cook range.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: North - mud flats. South - mountains and timbered country. East - level with open patches, to town. West - timbered country.

PETROL AND OIL: Cooktown.

WATER SUPPLY: At grandstand.

WORKSHOPS: Nil.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE & TELEGRAPH: Post Office, 1½ miles.

NEAREST TOWN AND PORT: Cooktown.

RAILWAY STATION: 1 mile north by road. (Cooktown-Laura Railway).

CHARGES: Nil.
