


 POSITION: Adjoining, and N.W. of Coolabah township and on N.E. of Bourke-Nyngan Railway.  
 Lat.  $31^{\circ}1'S.$  Long.  $146^{\circ}42\frac{1}{2}'E.$   
 MAGNETIC VARIATION:  $7\frac{1}{2}'E.$  approx.  
 DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Bourke-Nyngan Railway and Coolabah township.  
 MARKINGS: White Cross and Wind Indicator.  
 DESCRIPTION: One-way ground. Fair surface; should be suitable all weathers.  
 DIMENSIONS: N.W. - S.E. 600 yards. Width 260 yards.  
 HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 740 ft. approx.  
 APPROACHES: Low scrub on approaches; surrounded by heavy timber to 50 ft.; Tel. line and railway along S.W. boundary.  
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Heavily timbered.  
 PETROL AND OIL: Coolabah Township.
