


EMERGENCY LANDING GROUND



LATITUDE: 28° 10' S; LONGITUDE: 153° 30½' E; MAG. VAR: 9° E app.

ALTITUDE: 13 feet approx.

POSITION: About 1½ miles west of Coolangatta township.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet H.9.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Swampy coastal scrub.

LANDMARKS: Point Danger 2 miles east.

APPROACHES: Over low scrub.

MARKINGS: Ground mark (cross), wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: EW, 845 yds. NS, 780 yds. NW-SE, 900 yds.

SURFACE: 3 runways. Landings should be confined to runways.

TOWN: Coolangatta, 1½ miles E.

RAILWAY STATION: Bilinga, ¼ mile N.

TELEPHONE: Coolangatta.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS: Nil.

REFUELLING: Coolangatta.

WATER: Small tank on aerodrome.
