


LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: 33° 50' S; **LONGITUDE:** 148° 40' E; **MAG. VAR:** 9° E app.
ALTITUDE: 950 feet approx.

POSITION: 3 miles NW of town of Cowra.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet J.9. Stripmap No.73.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open cultivation paddocks. Suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Town of Cowra, 3 miles SE.

APPROACHES: North-east - some trees to 50 ft. high. South - windmill 25 ft. high. Elsewhere - clear.

MARKINGS: Wind indicator and boundary marks. Every eighth post on fence round landing area has been painted white.

LIGHTING: Nil.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 1,100 yds. E-W, 820 yds.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Cowra, 3½ miles SE.

TELEPHONE: At homestead.

HANGARS: One - 46' 6" span, 30' deep and 15' high.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: At Cowra.

WATER: At dam and homestead.

PROPRIETORS: Cowra Aero Club, Cowra.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Pilots should beware of dam near wind indicator.
