


LATITUDE: 25° 23' S; LONGITUDE: 150° 18' E; MAG.VAR: 7½° E.

ALTITUDE: 1,200 feet approx.

POSITION: Immediately S of Cracow homestead, about 5 miles S of Cracow township.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet G.9.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Very hilly and timbered.

LANDMARKS: Homestead immediately north, Cracow Creek north, west and south-west. Mt.Elvinia about 3 miles to north-east.

APPROACHES: Over felled timber and Creek (see sketch).

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 500 yds. NE-SW, 930 yds.

SURFACE: Fair.

TOWN: Cracow, 5 miles.

RAILWAY: Theodore, 32 miles NNW.
