


CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for light types of land-planes only.

PROPRIETORS: Crookwell and District Aero Club.

POSITION: 2½ miles south of Crookwell.

Lat. 34°30'S. Long. 149°27'E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 9°E. approx.

LANDMARKS: House near S.W. corner; road along eastern boundary,

MARKINGS: White semi-circle and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Generally smooth, but may be rough near eastern and southern boundaries. Dam in S.W. corner; old house and well in N.E. corner.

DIMENSIONS: N.-S., 440 yards. E.-W., 500 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 2,900 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: North - timber up to 40 ft. high. South - telephone line 20 ft. high. East - telephone line 10 ft. high. West - clear.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Hilly and timbered. Forced landings could be effected in fields adjacent to aerodrome.

PETROL AND OIL: Crookwell.

WATER SUPPLY: House about ¼ mile south-west.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE: At house beyond S.W. corner of aerodrome.

TELEGRAPH: Crookwell P.O.

NEAREST TOWN: Crookwell.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Crookwell.

CHARGES: Nil.
