

LICENSED AERODROME. "B" CLASS



LATITUDE:  $27^{\circ} 12' 8''$ ; LONGITUDE:  $151^{\circ} 16' E$ ; MAG.VAR:  $8\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E$ . app.

ALTITUDE: 1,120 feet approx.

POSITION: 1 mile SE of Dalby.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet G.9. Stripmap No.3.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Town to NW; Trees and houses elsewhere.

LANDMARKS: Dalby and prominent water tower immediately NW.

APPROACHES: Tel. and EL lines as per sketch, otherwise relatively clear.

MARKINGS: White circle and two wind indicators.

DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 750 yards; NE-SW, 760 yards.

SURFACE: Rough, but not dangerous.

TOWN, RAILWAY STATION & TELEPHONE: Dalby, 1 mile NW.

HANGARS: One hangar  $40' \times 30'$ . Charge 2/- per night.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Dalby.

WATER: On aerodrome.

PROPRIETORS: Dalby - Wambo Aerodrome Board, P.O. Box 77 Dalby, Q.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Tel. and EL lines 30' high near NE corner; radio masts 35' high near hangar; water tower 135' high  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile W of station (2 red lights at night).

Cattle sometimes graze at night, but rarely during daylight.
