IT is hereby notified that an Aerodrome has been established at DE GREY, WESTERN AUSTRALIA.

<i>Proprietors</i>	De Grey Pastoral Company, De Grey, via Port Hedland, Western Australia.
<i>Class of Aerodrome</i> ..	All types of landplanes.
<i>Position</i>	Latitude, 20° 11' S.; longitude, 119° 10' E. Situated about 47 miles east-north-east of Port Hedland.
<i>Distinctive Features</i> ..	Homestead, 1½ miles north-east.
<i>Markings</i>	Ground marking (circle). Wind indicator on northern boundary.
<i>Description</i>	A large claypan cleared and levelled of bumps.
<i>Dimensions for Landing</i>	500 yards north-west and south-east; 700 yards north-east and south-west.
<i>Height above Sea Level</i>	About 25 feet.
<i>Magnetic Variation</i> ..	0° 30' E. (approx.).
<i>Approaches</i>	North, scrub about 3 chains distant. South, clear. East, clear. West, clear.
<i>Surrounding Country</i> ..	Northwards, scrubby; southwards, scrubby with open patches.
<i>Petrol and Oil</i>	Probably available at Homestead, otherwise Port Hedland, 56 miles by road.
<i>Water Supply</i>	At Homestead.
<i>Workshops</i>	Port Hedland.
<i>Hangar Accommodation</i>	Nil.
<i>Nearest Telephone</i> ..	At Homestead.
<i>Nearest Telegraph</i> ..	Can be transmitted by telephone to Condon.
<i>Nearest Town</i>	Port Hedland.
<i>Nearest Railway Station</i>	Port Hedland nearest port.
<i>Charges</i>	Nil.
