


CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome, suitable for all types of landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: De Grey River Pastoral Co. Ltd.

POSITION: About $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles South-West of De Grey Homestead.

Lat: $20^{\circ} 11'$ S. Long: $119^{\circ} 10'$ E.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 1° E. approx.

LANDMARKS: De Grey River and Homestead.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

Boundaries marked with white tins.

SURFACE: A large claypan cleared and levelled.

DIMENSIONS: N.W.-S.E. 500 yards; N.E.-S.W. 850 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 25 feet approx.

APPROACHES: North-East and West - scrub 15 feet high.

Elsewhere clear.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Small sand hummocks up to 4 ft. high on all sides. Some scrub North and South.

PETROL, OIL and WORKSHOPS: Port Hedland, 50 miles W-S-W. by road.

WATER SUPPLY: At Homestead.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE and TELEGRAPH: At Homestead.

NEAREST TOWN and SEAPORT: Port Hedland.

CHARGES: Nil.
