




LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: 16° 59' S; LONGITUDE: 141° 18' E; MAG. VAR: 5½° E app.
ALTITUDE: 100 feet approx.

POSITION: About 58 miles by road N of Normanton, and 7 miles NW of Lotus Vale aerodrome. Immediately N of Delta Downs homestead.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet E.7. Stripmaps Nos.63 and 64.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered, with some open spaces suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Aerodrome is immediately N of homestead. Station Creek flows about 200 yards to S.

APPROACHES: South-west - over 35 ft. timber and 76 ft. radio mast. North-east - clear.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and corner posts painted white.

DIMENSIONS: NNW-SSE, 350 yds. WSW-ENE, 950 yds.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Normanton, 58 miles S.

TELEPHONE: A. I. M. wireless set at homestead.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Not available.

WATER: At homestead.

PROPRIETOR: Mr. S. Pointon, Delta Downs, via Normanton, Qld.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: The licence includes the use of the ground in wet weather, but only when wind conditions are favourable. Lotus Vale aerodrome, 7 miles SE, is suitable in all weathers.
