


GOVERNMENT AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE: $35^{\circ}33\frac{1}{2}'$ S. LONGITUDE: $144^{\circ}57\frac{1}{2}'$ E. MAG. VAR: $7\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. app.

ALTITUDE: 310 feet approx.

POSITION: About 2 miles south of Deniliquin, on west side of Echuca road.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet K.8. Stripmap No.30.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open and generally suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Deniliquin-Echuca road on east boundary.

APPROACHES: Fenced all round; trees 35 ft. high on southern half of west boundary, otherwise open.

MARKINGS: White circle, white tins mark southern boundary. Wind indicator, NE.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 770 yards; E-W, 880 yards.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Deniliquin, 2 miles north.

TELEPHONE: Deniliquin.

HANGARS: Nil.

REFUELLING: On aerodrome.

REPAIRS: Deniliquin garages.

WATER: At house $\frac{1}{4}$ mile west.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.

CHARGES: Nil.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Pilots are warned against sheep grazing on aerodrome.
