




EMERGENCY LANDING GROUND



LATITUDE: 26° 26' S; LONGITUDE: 147° 22' E; MAG. VAR: 7½° E app.

ALTITUDE: 1,450 feet approx.

POSITION: On S side of Brisbane-Charleville railway and adjacent to Dulbydilla railway station.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet G.8. Stripmap No. 3.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered. Generally unsuitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: "T" shaped ground, railway and Dulbydilla Station to N.

APPROACHES: North - over railway and 20' tel. line. Over timber in all other directions. Gaps felled.

MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.

DIMENSIONS: N-S, 570 yds. E-W, 570 yds.

SURFACE: Good.

TOWN: Morven, 16 miles W.

RAILWAY STATION: Dulbydilla.

TELEPHONE: Dulbydilla.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Morven.

WATER: Railway station or dam.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.
