



NOTICE TO AIRMEN.

NO. 9/1933.
DUNOLLY, VIC.

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for light types of land-planes only.

PROPRIETORS: Shire Council of Bet Bet, Dunolly, Victoria.

POSITION: One mile South-West of Dunolly.

Lat. $36^{\circ} 52\frac{1}{2}'$ S. Long. $143^{\circ} 43\frac{1}{2}'$ E.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Road along East boundary. Grandstand buildings on Western side.

MARKINGS: White semi-circle and Wind Indicator.

DESCRIPTION: Rectangular shaped aerodrome with grassed surface sloping slightly downwards to North and East boundaries.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 570 yds. E. - W. 410 yds.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 630 ft. approx.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: 7° E. approx.

APPROACHES: North, clear.

East, clear except for furlong posts.

West, timber 40 feet with cleared approach South of grandstand.

South, timber 40 feet, and furlong post.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timber and low hills unsuitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: Dunolly.

WATER SUPPLY: Dam near South West corner.

WORKSHOPS: Dunolly.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

NEAREST TELEPHONE: At house $\frac{1}{4}$ -mile N.E. Dunolly 53.

NEAREST TELEGRAPH: Dunolly P.O.

NEAREST TOWN: Dunolly, 1 mile North-East.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Dunolly, 1 mile North East.

CHARGES: Nil.

REMARKS: The Northern portion of the aerodrome is likely to be soft after rain. Relative strip map No.47.
