




CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.
 PROPRIETORS: Civil Aviation Board, Melbourne.
 POSITION: In fork of railway junction, about 1½ miles South of Echuca. Lat.: 36° 09' S. Long.: 144° 46' E.
 MAGNETIC VARIATION: 8° East approx.
 LANDMARKS: Railway junction and town of Echuca.
 MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.
 SURFACE: Fair, fenced all around.
 DIMENSIONS: North-South 720 yards; East-West 800 yards.
 HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 320 feet approx.
 APPROACHES: East - telephone along rifle range, otherwise open.
 West - telegraph lines along railway.
 North and South - open.
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally open and suitable for forced landings.
 PETROL, OIL and WORKSHOPS: Echuca, 1½ miles north.
 WATER SUPPLY: Houses to North.
 HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
 TELEPHONE and TELEGRAPH: Echuca.
 NEAREST TOWN and RAILWAY STATION: Echuca.
 CHARGES: Nil.
 REMARKS: Stripmap No. 30.
