


LATITUDE: $29^{\circ} 47' S$; LONGITUDE: $122^{\circ} 15' E$; MAG. VAR: $\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$. app.
 ALTITUDE: 1,000 feet approx.

POSITION: About 6 miles west of township of Yarri, and about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile west of Edjudina Mine, on north side of Kalgoorlie Rd.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet H.4.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Rough and scrub covered.

LANDMARKS: Road adjacent to southern boundary, mine buildings about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile east.

APPROACHES: Trees 15 ft. high all round.

MARKINGS: Wind indicator and white circle.

DIMENSIONS: 750 yards by 600 yards.

SURFACE: Smooth gravelly loam.

TOWN: Yarri, 6 miles east.

RAILWAY STATION: Kookynie, 65 miles NW by road.

TELEPHONE: Edjudina Mine, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile east.

HANGARS: Nil.
