




LATITUDE: 31° 29' S; LONGITUDE: 147° 31' E; MAG. VAR: 8° E. app.  
 ALTITUDE: 650 feet approx.  
 POSITION: On south side of Duck Creek, 21 miles NW of Warren,  
 and 21 miles ENE of Nyngan.  
 RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet J.8. Stripmap No.60.  
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Belts of timber with some open patches,  
 suitable for forced landings.  
 LANDMARKS: Eenaweena Homestead ½ mile SE Duck Creek on north  
 and east.  
 APPROACHES: North - low scrub and scattered trees. South-west  
 - tel. line 12 ft. high. Remainder clear.  
 MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.  
 DIMENSIONS: 660 yards in all directions.  
 SURFACE: Good level surface.

TOWN: Warren, 23 miles SE by road.  
 RAILWAY STATION: Warren.  
 TELEPHONE: Eenaweena Station (Tel.No. - Warren 45).  
 HANGARS: Nil.  
 REFUELLING: Limited supply at homestead.
