


**CLASS OF GROUND:** Emergency Landing Ground.  
**PROPRIETOR:** C.W.Blake, Esq., Wau, New Guinea.  
**POSITION:** At the junction of the Efa Creek and the Lower Watut River, and about 40 miles NW of Wau.  
Lat:  $6^{\circ} 51' 11''$  S; Long:  $146^{\circ} 21'$  E.  
**MAGNETIC VARIATION:**  $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E approx.  
**LANDMARKS:** Junction of the Efa Creek and the Lower Watut River immediately south.  
**MARKINGS:** Nil.  
**SURFACE:** Cut Kunai grass surface; inclined to be soft after rain.  
**DIMENSIONS:** Single strip, 320 yards by 50 yards wide.  
**HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL:** 500 ft. approx.  
**APPROACHES:** From NE; over low scrub then clear for 500 yards. From SW; kunai hills then clear.  
**SURROUNDING COUNTRY:** Mountainous.  
**PETROL & OIL:** Limited reserve at Wau, about 40 miles south east.  
**WATER SUPPLY:** Efa Creek.  
**WORKSHOPS:** Wau.  
**HANGAR ACCOMMODATION:** Nil.  
**TELEGRAPH:** Radio Bulolo, about 30 miles south east.  
**NEAREST TOWN:** Wau.  
**NEAREST SEAPORT:** Lae, about 45 miles east.  
**CHARGES:** Nil.
