


LICENSED AERODROME - C CLASS



LATITUDE:  $30^{\circ} 4\frac{1}{2}'$  S; LONGITUDE:  $138^{\circ} 18'$  E; MAG. VAR:  $6^{\circ}$  E. app.

ALTITUDE: 300 feet approx.

POSITION: About  $1\frac{1}{4}$  miles east of Farina.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet H.7, Strip maps Nos. 14, 36, and 70.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open, undulating with stones and washouts, hilly to S.W.

LANDMARKS: Railway line  $1\frac{1}{4}$  miles to west. Track to Farina on north of ground.

APPROACHES: Open all round except for hills on south-west and low sand ridge on north-west. Posts at end of north-east run.

MARKINGS: The letter "F" inlaid in white on a black circular background.

DIMENSIONS: NE-SW, 460 yds; NW-SE, 750 yds; E-W, 470 yds.

SURFACE: Level clay pan area. Irregular shape defined by mounds and sandy grass tussocks.

TOWN and RAILWAY STATION: Farina  $1\frac{1}{4}$  miles west.

TELEPHONE: Farina Post Office.

HANGARS: Nil.

REFUELLING and REPAIRS: Farina.

WATER: Farina.

PROPRIETORS: Messrs. Bell Bros., Farina, S.A.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Surface possibly a little soft immediately after rain.
