

CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency Landing Ground.
PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil Aviation, Melbourne).
POSITION: Lat. 18°19'S. Long. 128°E. About 1 mile N.E. of homestead.
MAGNETIC VARIATION: About 2½°E.
DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: River to West and hills to North.
MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator on Eastern boundary.
DESCRIPTION: Good hard surface of gravel. Hard in all weather.
DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 580 yards.
 E. - W. 630 yards.
HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: About 1,000 feet.
APPROACHES: West, scattered trees. Remainder low scrub. Telephone line 300 yards from South boundary.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally open. Forced landings may be possible.
PETROL AND OIL: At homestead.
WATER SUPPLY: At homestead.
WORKSHOPS: Blacksmiths' tools at station. Wyndham Meat Works, roughly 320 miles.
HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
TELEPHONE: At station.
TELEGRAPH: Hall's Creek Post Office.
NEAREST TOWN: Wyndham, roughly 320 miles.
REMARKS: Relative Strip Map No. 56.




EMERGENCY LANDING GROUND



LATITUDE: 18° 19' S; LONGITUDE: 128° 00' E; MAG. VAR. 2½° E.

ALTITUDE: 1000 feet approx.

POSITION: ½ mile north-east from Homestead.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet E.5, Stripmap 56.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally open to south, forced landings may be possible. Ranges to north.

LANDMARKS: Stock routes, rivers to east and west, hills to north. Telephone line to south.

APPROACHES: Scattered scrub to north; scattered scrub and telephone line to south; scrub and hummocks to east; timber to 30' high on west.

MARKINGS: White cross, wind indicator, and corner marks.

DIMENSIONS: East-west, 600 yds.; north-south, 560 yds.

SURFACE: Generally good and should be hard in all weathers.

Washouts likely to occur near boundaries.

TOWN: Hall's Creek, approx. 20 mile north-west.

SEAPORT: Wyndham, approx. 320 miles north.

TELEPHONE: At Homestead, ½ mile south-west.

HANGAR: Nil.

REPAIRS: Wyndham.

REFUELLING: Limited supplies at Homestead.

WATER: At Homestead.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.

CHARGES: Nil.
