


CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for all types of landplanes.
PROPRIETORS: Australian Pastoral Coy., Sydney, N.S.W.

POSITION: 21 miles N.N.E. of Cloncurry, and 3 miles N. by E. of
Fort Constantine Homestead. On West side of Cloncurry River.
Lat. $20^{\circ} 26' S.$ Long. $140^{\circ} 37' E.$

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} E.$ approx.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Cloncurry River on East. Road and tele-
phone line adjacent to Western boundary. Fort Constantine
homestead 3 miles S. by W., consists of 6 red roofed buildings
MARKINGS: White Circle and Wind Indicator.

DESCRIPTION: Aerodrome is on red clay pan with smooth, hard
surface, - unfenced.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 830 yards.
E. - W. 650 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 630 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: N., S., & W., scattered timber.
E., heavy timber.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Timbered hills to South; otherwise plain
country with scattered timber.

PETROL AND OIL: Limited supply at Fort Constantine homestead.

WATER SUPPLY: At Homestead.

WORKSHOPS: At Homestead.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

NEAREST TELEPHONE: Homestead.

NEAREST TOWN: Cloncurry, 22 miles S.S.W. by road.

NEAREST RAILWAY STATION: Cloncurry, 22 miles S.S.W. by road.

REMARKS: Pilots should observe for cattle before landing, as
the aerodrome is not fenced.
