


LATITUDE: 34°48' S. LONGITUDE: 147°02½' E. MAG.VAR: 8° E. app.
 ALTITUDE: 600 feet approx.
 POSITION: 3 miles SE of Ganmain, and 1½ miles S of railway line.
 RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet K.8. Stripmap No.73.
 SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Cultivated with scattered trees, suitable for forced landings.
 LANDMARKS: Homestead, sheds and hangar about centre of south boundary - small dam just outside SW corner. "Ganmain" painted on roof of shed.
 APPROACHES: South - over few scattered trees, 7' tel. line, homestead, sheds, hangar and "Windlyte" 30' high; north, east and west - clear except for few scattered trees.
 MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.
 DIMENSIONS: N-S, 500 yards; E-W, 660 yards.
 SURFACE: Good.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Ganmain, 3 miles NW.
 TELEPHONE: At homestead, Ganmain 96.
 HANGARS: One 40' x 30' for private use.
 REPAIRS: Ganmain.
 REFUELLING & WATER: At homestead.
