CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for single-engined land-planes only.

PROPRIETORS: Administration, Territory of New Guinea.

POSITION: On Waria River Flats.

Lat. $7^{\circ}52'S$. Long. $147^{\circ}9'E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $6^{\circ}E$. approx.

DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Open flat grass country. Waria River $\frac{1}{4}$ mile to the east. Native Huts $\frac{1}{4}$ mile south-east.

MARKINGS: Nil.

DESCRIPTION: Single runway cut in grass on open river flat.

DIMENSIONS: N.W. - S.E. 450 yards by 65 yards wide.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 2200 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: Over open grass flat from N.W.

Over flat with few trees from S.E.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flat, suitable for forced landings.

PETROL AND OIL: Nil.

WATER SUPPLY: In creeks.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEGRAPH: (Radio). Wau, about 50 miles N.N.W.
