


(BELMONT COMMON) GEELONG, VIC.

(REVISED - JANUARY, 1941)

LICENSED AERODROME - "C" CLASS



LATITUDE: $38^{\circ} 10\frac{1}{2}'$ S; LONGITUDE: $144^{\circ} 21\frac{1}{2}'$ E; MAG. VAR: 8° E app.
ALTITUDE: 10 feet approx.

POSITION: Part of Belmont Common, on right bank of the Barwon River, immediately south of the city of Geelong.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator Sheet L.8.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Open country clear of town is suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Barwon River to N and E; City of Geelong immediately N.

APPROACHES: North and south - open; east - over factories with high smoke stacks, east of river; west - over houses, trees and road embankment.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: NW-SE, 506 yards. NE-SW, 495 yards.

SURFACE: Fair.

TOWN: City of Geelong, immediately north.

RAILWAY STATION: South Geelong, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile north.

TELEPHONE: At hangar (phone Geelong 2525).

HANGARS: Two.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: On aerodrome.

WATER: On aerodrome.

PROPRIETORS: The Geelong Harbour Trust Commissioners, Geelong.

CHARGES: No landing fees. Hangar accommodation 5/- for each 24 hours or part thereof.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Pilots should watch for stock grazing on aerodromes.
