


LICENSED AERODROME, "C" CLASS



LATITUDE: 18°14' S. LONGITUDE: 143°28½' E. MAG. VAR: 5° E. approx.
 ALTITUDE: 800 feet approx.

POSITION: 8 miles NW of Georgetown in fork of Four Mile and Sutherland Creeks.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet E.8. Stripmap No.63.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Undulating, timber country with deep water courses; not suitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Etheridge River about 2 miles north and junction of Four Mile and Sutherland Creeks about 1 mile NW.

APPROACHES: Completely surrounded by trees about 30 feet high except for belt of stumps ranging from 5 to 2 chains in width as shown in sketch.

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: WNW-ESE, 745 yards; NNE-SSW, 700 yards.

SURFACE: Fair.

TOWN: Georgetown, 8 miles SE.

RAILWAY STATION: Forsayth, 35 miles south.

TELEPHONE: Georgetown.

HANGARS: Nil.

REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Georgetown.

WATER: Adjacent creeks.

PROPRIETORS: Etheridge Shire Council, Georgetown, Queensland.

CHARGES: Nil at present.

SPECIAL REMARKS: This ground is licensed in dry weather only and is liable to be cancelled at any time during wet weather. Licence covers use by D.H.84 and D.H.89 with loading restricted to 4,320 lb.
