

CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome suitable for all types of landplanes.

PROPRIETORS: Commonwealth of Australia (Controller of Civil

Aviation, Melbourne).

POSITION: 3 miles east of Geraldton.

Lat. $28^{\circ} 47' S$. Long. $114^{\circ} 39\frac{1}{2}' E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $3\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} W$. approx.

LANDMARKS: Road on southern boundary.

MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.

SURFACE: Sandy, grassed and fairly smooth.

DIMENSIONS: N. - S. 830 yards. E. - W. 700 yards.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 50 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: Generally clear; clump of trees west and a few trees east.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Scrubby, with some open cultivated paddocks.

PETROL AND OIL: At aerodrome.

WATER SUPPLY: At aerodrome.

WORKSHOPS: Geraldton.

HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.

TELEPHONE AND TELEGRAPH: Geraldton Post Office.

NEAREST TOWN: Geraldton.

RAILWAY STATION: Utakarra Siding, 1 mile west.
