



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

GILBERT RIVER, QLD.

- CLASS OF GROUND: Aerodrome licensed for single-engined and light multi-engined landplanes.
- PROPRIETORS: Etheridge Shire Council, Georgetown, North Queensland.
- POSITION: About 2 miles North of Gilbert River Telegraph Station, on North-eastern side of Gilbert River.
 Lat. $18^{\circ} 7'$ S. Long. $142^{\circ} 51'$ E.
- MAGNETIC VARIATION: $5\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E. approx.
- DISTINCTIVE FEATURES: Angle in Telegraph Line about 1 mile N.W.; Gilbert River about 1 mile S.W.
- MARKINGS: White circle and wind indicator.
- DESCRIPTION: Sandy clay surface; falls towards the centre from N.W., N.E. and S.E. Boundaries.
- DIMENSIONS: N.E. - S.W. 660 yards.
 N.W. - S.E. 660 yards.
- HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 500 feet approx.
- APPROACHES: Timber felled 100 yards back from all boundaries.
 Ground rises to N.W. and S.E.
- SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Flat and timbered; unsuitable for forced landings.
- PETROL AND OIL: Small quantities available at Police Station.
- WATER SUPPLY: Gilbert River, 1 mile S.W.
- WORKSHOPS: Nil.
- HANGAR ACCOMMODATION: Nil.
- TELEPHONE: Telegraph Station, 2 miles South.
- TELEGRAPH: Telegraph Station.
- NEAREST TOWN: Georgetown, 50 miles E.S.E. by road.
