


LATITUDE: 31° 21' S; **LONGITUDE:** 115° 54' E; **MAG. VAR:** 4½° W. app.
ALTITUDE: 300 feet approx.
POSITION: 1½ miles south of Gin Gin township, on old racecourse.
RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet J.3, Stripmap No.53.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Scrub, unsuitable for forced landings.
LANDMARKS: Railway line, and township of Gin Gin.
APPROACHES: Telephone line and railway on east, timber felled on north, south, east and west approaches (See sketch).
MARKINGS: White cross and wind indicator.
DIMENSIONS: North-south, 630 yards; east-west, 660 yards.
SURFACE: Good. Firm sandy soil, well bound.

TOWN and RAILWAY STATION: Gin Gin, 1½ miles north.
TELEPHONE: Gin Gin Post Office.
HANGAR: Nil.
REPAIRS: Midland Junction 40 miles south.
REFUELLING: Gin Gin.
WATER: Gin Gin.
