


LICENSED AERODROME, "B" CLASS



LATITUDE:  $18^{\circ} 44\frac{1}{2}'$  S. LONGITUDE:  $128^{\circ} 34\frac{1}{2}'$  E. MAG. VAR:  $3^{\circ}$  E. app.

ALTITUDE: 900 feet approx.

POSITION: 75 miles south-east of Hall's Creek township.

RELEVANT AVIATION MAP: Mercator sheet E.5.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Generally wooded. Some open spaces, but unsuitable for forced landings.

LANDMARKS: Sturt Creek to west; hills to south-west; Gordon Downs Homestead  $1\frac{1}{2}$  miles east.

APPROACHES: Scrub and timber to height of 15 ft. (see sketch).

MARKINGS: White circle, wind indicator and boundary marks.

DIMENSIONS: 920 yards x 700 yards, across corners.

SURFACE: Smooth red soil.

TOWN: Hall's Creek, 75 miles north-west.

SEAPORT: Wyndham, 350 miles north.

TELEPHONE: Wireless-telephone at homestead.

HANGARS: Nil.

REFUELLING & REPAIRS: Limited resources at homestead.

WATER: At homestead.

PROPRIETOR: Mr. B.B.Hudson, Gordon Downs Station, via Hall's Creek.

CHARGES: Nil at present.
