



NOTICE TO AIRMEN

GROOTE EYLANDT, N.T.



CLASS OF GROUND: Emergency landing ground.

PROPRIETORS: Church Mission Society.

POSITION: Near south-west extremity of Groote Eylandt, $\frac{1}{2}$ mile east of Mission Station. Lat: $14^{\circ}5'S$. Long: $136^{\circ}26'E$.

MAGNETIC VARIATION: $4\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}E$. approx.

LANDMARKS: Mission Station, about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile west of landing ground.

MARKINGS: Nil.

SURFACE, ETC. Gravelly and hard sand. Good in all weather.

DIMENSIONS: N.W. - S.E. 590 yds. N.E. - S.W. 300 yds.

HEIGHT ABOVE SEA LEVEL: 50 ft. approx.

APPROACHES: All tall timber felled for 150 to 200 yards, and scrub cut for 30 yards back from boundary of prepared area.

SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Undulating and heavily timbered.

PETROL AND OIL: Nil.

WATER SUPPLY: At stream nearby.

WORKSHOPS: At Mission Station.
