


LATITUDE: $34^{\circ} 48' S$; LONGITUDE: $149^{\circ} 16' E$; MAG. VAR: $9^{\circ} E$ app.
ALTITUDE: 1,896 feet approx.
POSITION: Situated $\frac{1}{2}$ mile south of Gunning township.
RELEVANT AVIATION MAPS: Mercator Sheet K.9. Stripmap No. 12.
SURROUNDING COUNTRY: Rough and hilly.
LANDMARKS: In fork of creeks west of Collector Road.
APPROACHES: North and south - clear; east - over trees and tel. line along road; west - over few dead trees.
MARKINGS: White cross, wind indicator and boundary marks.
DIMENSIONS: N-S, 720 yards. E-W, 560 yards.
SURFACE: Fair.

TOWN & RAILWAY STATION: Gunning $\frac{1}{2}$ mile north.
TELEPHONE: Gunning.
HANGARS: Nil.
REPAIRS & REFUELLING: Gunning.
WATER: At nearby house.

PROPRIETORS: Department of Civil Aviation, Melbourne.
CHARGES: Nil.

SPECIAL REMARKS: Occasionally used as a racecourse.
